

BOAT SLIPS DOCKING POLICY

- DOCKS ARE FOR TEMPORARY USE ONLY
- ALL USERS ARE REQUIRED TO FOLLOW STATE AND LOCAL BOATING LAWS AND TO OBSERVE STANDARD SAFETY PROCEDURES. IT IS ILLEGAL TO DISCHARGE HEADS AT THIS DOCK.
- USERS ALSO SHOULD DOCK THEIR BOAT IN WAYS THAT ALLOW AS MUCH ACCESS TO DOCKS AS POSSIBLE FOR OTHER BOATS. ALL USERS ARE EXPECTED TO SHOW RESPECT AND CONSIDERATION FOR OTHER BOATERS AND THOSE USING THE PIERS AND BOARDWALK FOR NON-BOATING PURPOSES.
- USERS WISHING TO DOCK A BOAT AT THE SLIPS FOR MORE THAN 48 HOURS MUST OBTAIN DIRECT APPROVAL FROM THE TOWN OF WINDSOR (CONTACT ALLEN CASTELLOE, TOWN ADMINISTRATOR)

ANY BOAT DOCKED MORE THAN 48 HOURS WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL SHALL BE SUBJECT TO: (A) PHYSICAL SEARCH FOR IDENTIFICATION OF OWNERSHIP; (B) SECURING OF BOAT TO THE DOCK; (C) LOSS OF FUTURE DOCKING PRIVILEGES; AND/OR (D) SEIZURE BY AUTHORITIES. OWNER MAY ALSO BE REQUIRED TO PAY FOR ANY DAMAGES AND EXPENSES INCURRED.

THE DOCKS ARE OWNED AND MAINTAINED BY THE TOWN OF WINDSOR.
